in front of the Statue of Mary in the courtyard between the church and parish center.

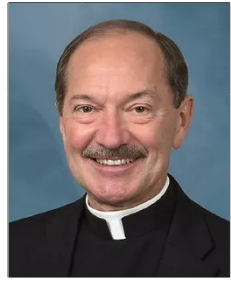
