

Do not send only a flier or image. Include the following details in a text format (copy into email or attach a word processing file):

- -Event title
- -One sentence summary
- -Date(s) or deadline
- -Starting time (or "All Day")
- -Location name
- -Location address
- -Attach a square photo/logo\*

Optional event details:

- -Link to event page that you update (no additional information required!!)
- -Event Type (see list at org/upcoming-events/)
- -Location photo and County (if new)
- -Bulletin announcement (2-3 sentences)
- -Detailed text description
- -Organizer (name, email, phone number)
- -Schedule details: end date/time, multi-day event, or repeating event
- -Resource link (ex: main website, social media account)
- -Document attachments (registration form, flier) in JPEG, DOCX or PDF format
- -Tags, a.k.a. search engine keywords

\*If a square photo/logo is not included, then we will use a stock photo, or convert any submitted fliers or banners into a square image. This increases our required staff time and delays publication of events. Best practice is to send a square photo that you own without text in JPEG format, RBG coloring, between 72dpi to 300dpi, and up to 750×750 pixels.

## Office of Pro-Life, Marriage, and Family Life

Two Proposed Amendments to Ohio's Constitution. Please Do Not get them Confused!

At the end of February the Catholic Bishops of Ohio jointly issued a letter in which they warn Catholics and all people of good will that "In Ohio, the dignity of life in its earliest stages is threatened by groups proposing an amendment to Ohio's Constitution for the November 2023 ballot that would enshrine and expand abortion at the expense of protections for preborn children and women" and they encourage us to vote against this amendment.

In the meantime, another amendment to the Ohio Constitution is being proposed in a special election on August 8: Issue One, which would "require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters voting on the proposed amendment." Our Ohio Catholic Bishops have taken a neutral stance on Issue One on the August ballot since it does not have any direct moral content.

To summarize, while the Catholic Bishops of Ohio are encouraging us to vote NO on the abortion amendment on the November ballot (remember, "NO" in NOvember), they are not taking a position one way or another on Issue One on the upcoming August ballot.

### Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship

Part I is the teaching document of the Catholic Bishops of the United States on the political responsibility of Catholics. It provides guidance for all who seek to exercise their rights and duties as citizens. As Catholics, we bring the richness of our faith to the public square. We draw from both faith and reason as we seek to affirm the dignity of the human person and the common good of all.

Part II is a consideration of the process by which these principles are applied to the act of voting and taking positions on policy issues. See the church bulletin boards for more information.

Did you know that families who receive food stamps assistance cannot use their benefits to purchase taxable products, such as hand soap, body soap or deodorant?


