



46 Rosaries in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe

The 46 rosaries represents the 46 stars printed on the mantle of the image of Guadalupe. Traditionally, families will pray a rosary for the intentions of the parish through the intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe, leading up to her feast on December 12th.


