





46 Rosaries in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe

¿Por qué 46 rosarios? Es un número simbólico para representar el número de estrellas impresas en el manto de la imagen de Guadalupe. La devoción se conserva hasta el día de hoy; como todo encuentro de fe, es una práctica agradable a Dios y por su medio consta que se han alcanzado muchos favores.

The 46 rosaries represents the 46 stars printed on the mantle of the image of Guadalupe. Traditionally, families will pray a rosary for the intentions of the parish through the intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe, leading up to her feast on December 12th.

Families who would like to pray a rosary during this 46 day period should sign up after the Spanish Mass on Sundays at 5:00 PM. Let us see the mercy of God at work through the prayers of the faithful!




