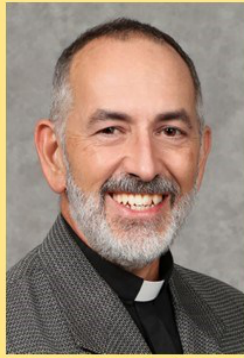

The Conversion of Saint Paul the Apostle

Before becoming a Christian, Paul's name was Saul. As a well-known Pharisee, Saul opposed Christians. One day Saul set out on a journey towards Damascus to find and imprison Christians there. Along the way he saw a bright light in the sky. It was so bright that he fell to the ground. Then he heard a voice saying "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" Who are you, sir?" he replied. I am Jesus the Nazorean whom you are persecuting " the voice replied. Saul was blinded by the light. Jesus sent him to Damascus to meet a disciple named Ananias, who had also seen a vision of Jesus. Jesus told him about Saul's arrival in Damascus and despite Ananias's objections, instructed him to heal the man when he arrived. Ananias met Saul in the streets of Damascus.
