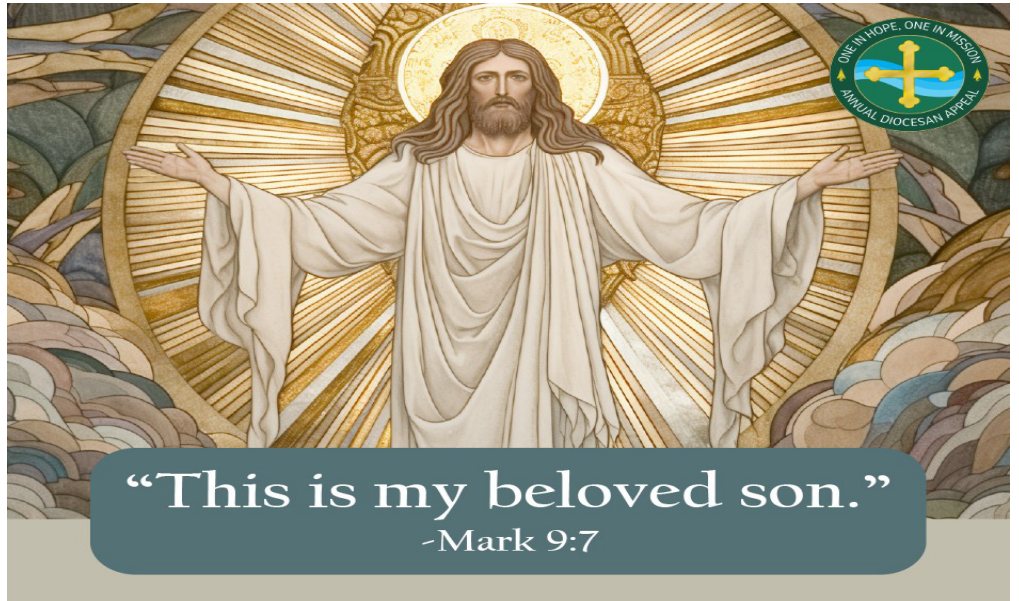
### Annual K of C "SOUP NIGHT"

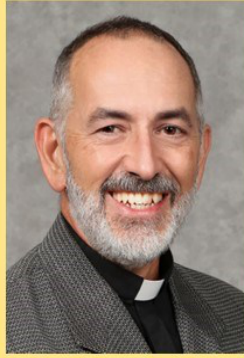
