



### Lenten Suggestions



You can give up something for Lent and/or <u>you can add</u> something for Lent:

- +Reading daily scripture
- +Praying a novena
- +Volunteering your time at a pantry
- +Attending daily Mass
- +Going to Adoration

Don't tell others or brag about *how* or *what* you are fasting. Keep it between you and God. (Matthew 6:5-6, 17-18)

Find strength in fasting. Even if you are feeling worn out from fasting, smile for others and appear joyful. (Matthew 6:16)

If you can save money from something you are giving up (maybe from daily coffee trips) think about setting that money aside for the poor. Think about this equation: (Cost of coffee per day x 40 days for Lent = (Amount to give to the poor)


