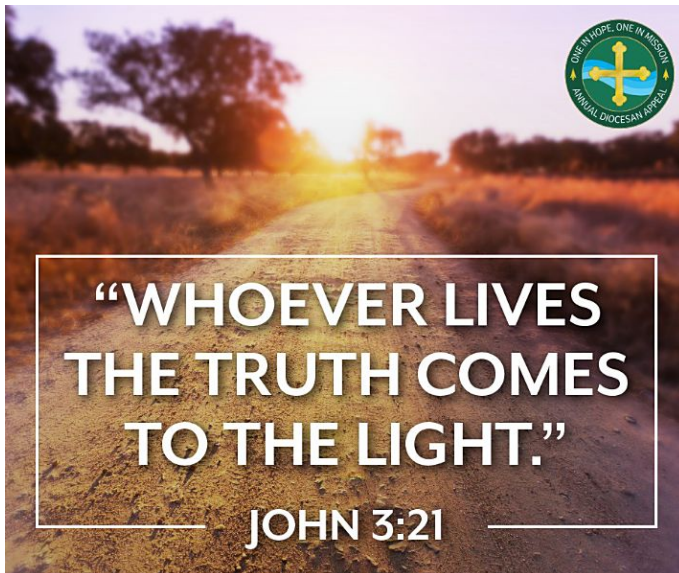

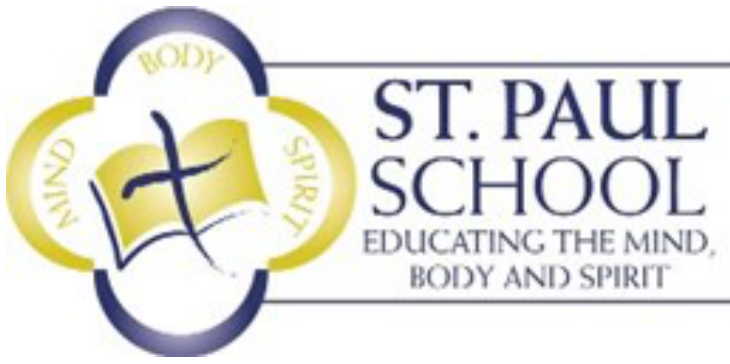

St. Paul School OSLN Design Challenge



102 students at St. Paul School tackled the question: “How do we improve the health and well-being of astronauts aboard Starlab orbiting the earth?” as part of the statewide Ohio STEM Learning Network (OSLN) 2024 Design Challenge #STEMorbitsOhio. Working in small groups, students in kindergarten through grade 7 learned about life in space and used the school’s STEM design process to create prototypes. The school hosted Dottie Metcalf-Lindenburger, a retired astronaut, and the Carnegie Science Center mobile planetarium as part of their research. Students then submitted presentations on their prototypes and the engineering process.

Two St. Paul School teams were named finalists by the Ohio STEM Learning Network and invited to a statewide showcase at Battelle Headquarters in Columbus on February 23 to compete for the state title. This was an honor, as only 21 teams received invitations. Fourth grade finalists Lindsay Anderson, Connor Halverstadt, Abigail Kotel, and Maria Miguel-Felix competed in the elementary (grades K-5) level with their design for physical fitness in space. Seventh grade finalists Lexi Anderson, Kaelyn de la Paz, and Diondra Stahl competed in the middle school category with their space aesthetics designs for astronaut comfort. Students spent the day presenting about their designs and solutions to NASA administrators, engineers, scientists, politicians, and dignitaries. The seventh grade team received the OSLN Akron Hub award.

St. Paul School art & design teacher Darby Hall coached the students for this competition. “The design process of asking, imagining, planning, creating, improving, and presenting serves many facets of the students’ lives and academic activities. St. Paul School students engage in rigorous problem-based learning as part of our Ohio STEM designation. This competition brought our whole school together to “dream big” and create solutions that improve life in outer space. The experience at the state competition was transformative—we are so proud of these wonderful young researchers!”

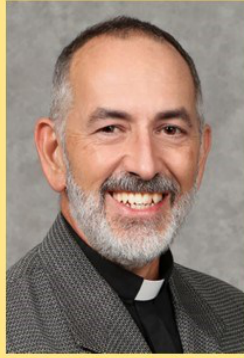
