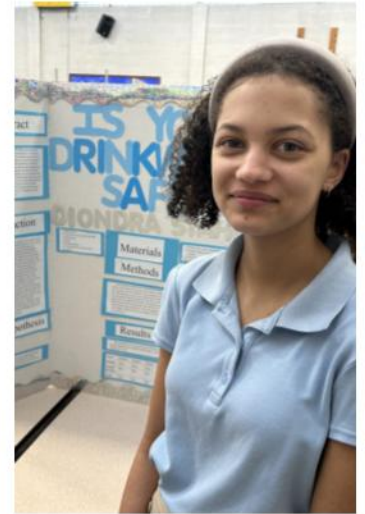

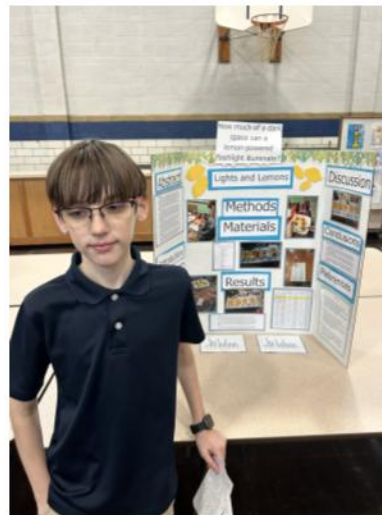

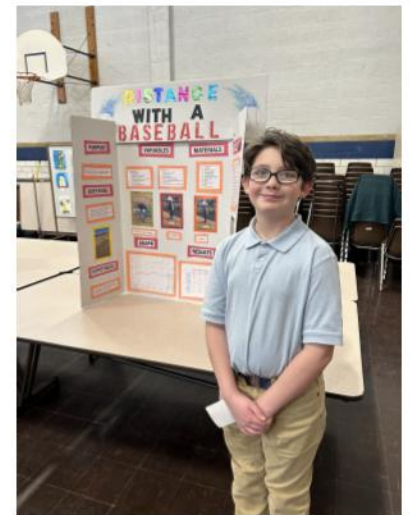

## Science Fair

29 students in grades 5, 6, and 7 participated in the 2024 local science fair at St. Paul School on 2/21/24. After conducting research on a wide variety of subjects, students presented their projects to 10 expert judges. Six student projects received "superior" ratings, 19 student projects received "excellent" ratings, and 2 student projects received "good" ratings. All students receiving superior ratings advance to the Lake-to-River District Science Day at Youngstown State on March 16.

Principal Dr. Jacqueline Mumford stated, "We are thrilled that these six young scholars will be moving on to the Lake-to-River Science Day at Youngstown State. The science fair is a hallmark of the St. Paul School student experience--a combination of rigorous academic research, scientific inquiry, technical writing, and scholarly presentation. We are very proud of all of our science fair participants this year!"

St. Paul School features a STREAM (Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) learning ecosystem where students engage in solving real-world problems. 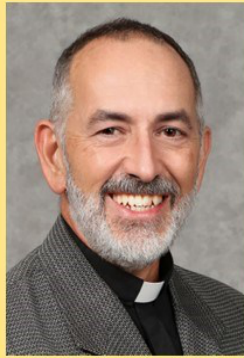
