2024 St. Paul School Reading Fair



EdChoice Scholarship Available for Catholic Schools

As a result of Ohio House Bill 33, signed into law on July 4, 2023, all K-12 students in Ohio are now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship that can be used toward Catholic School tuition. This includes currently enrolled children as well as any new student beginning their Catholic School experience.

The EdChoice Scholarship will cover a portion, or in some cases, the full cost of a family's Catholic school tuition. A student's specific EdChoice amount depends on the family's 2023 gross

adjusted income and family size. The amount could be as much as \$6,166 per year for a student in grades K-8, and \$8,408 per year for a student in grades 9-12.


