



Landscape Committee seeks help in four specific areas:

Trimming trees and shrubs – once or twice a year Spring &/or Fall
Need people who have trimmers and can get on ladders to do tall shrubs
Need people to clean up after the trim

Remove dead shrubs and trees and replace as needed

2. Weeding:

Around church, parish center, and school - once or twice a month Spraying for weeds before mulching followed by mulching - once a year in spring

- 3. Watering plants around the Mary statue and church sign Can be daily or weekly depending on the weather
- 4, Trimming of the rose bushes after they bloom

Two tree and shrub trimming companies each gave estimates of \$1800 + to complete the above work for St. Paul in 2024.


