



TO HELP WITH PARISH LANDSCAPE

Landscape Committee needs help in four specific areas:

- Trimming trees and shrubs once or twice a year Spring &/or Fall
 Need people who have trimmers and can get on ladders to do tall shrubs
 Need people to clean up after the trim
 - Remove dead shrubs and trees and replace as needed
- Weeding around church, parish center, and school once or twice a month Spraying for weeds before mulching followed by mulching - once a year in spring
- Watering plants around the Mary statue and church sign Can be daily or weekly depending on the weather
- 4, Trimming of the rose bushes after they bloom

A check with two tree/shrub trimming companies gave an estimate of at least \$1800 + and the other at least \$2000 + to do it for St. Paul in 2024.

So, it's up to parishioners - let's share talents/skills & friendship


