O'Malley offers a concise introduction to Catholic teaching on real presence and transubstantiation through a biblical, theological, and spiritual account of these doctrines from the early Church to today. He also explores how real presence enables us to see the vulnerability of human life and the dignity of all flesh and blood.

Here is a cat who does what she likes regardless of what others, even someone like the Pope, expects of her—even when the Queen of England comes on a state visit!

LOOKING FOR PEOPLE WITH TIME AND TALENT TO HELP WITH PARISH LANDSCAPE

Landscape Committee needs help in four specific areas:

1. Trimming trees and shrubs – once or twice a year Spring &/or Fall
Need people who have trimmers and can get on ladders to do tall shrubs
Need people to clean up after the trim
Remove dead shrubs and trees and replace as needed
2. Weeding around church, parish center, and school - once or twice a month
Spraying for weeds before mulching followed by mulching
- once a year in spring
3. Watering plants around the Mary statue and church sign
Can be daily or weekly depending on the weather
4. Trimming of the rose bushes – after they bloom

A check with two tree/shrub trimming companies gave an estimate of at least \$1800 + and the other at least \$2000 + to do it for St. Paul in 2024.

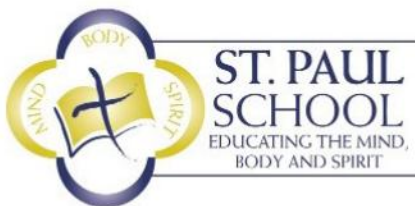
