LITURGICAL MINISTRY TRAINING
AND "REFRESHER" WORKSHOPS
FOR ALL NEW OR RETURNING MINISTERS**

Fr. Ruggieri will be leading an in-depth *Liturgy Workshop* on *Saturday, September 28, from 9am to 12noon*, for anyone interested in learning more about the spirituality of the Mass, and what "*full, conscious and active participation*" in the Liturgy is all about! Stay tuned for additional details.

Fr. Ruggieri also invites all current and interested new Liturgical Ministers (*Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and Altar Servers*) at both St. Paul Parish and St. Patrick Parish to participate in an upcoming training and "refresher" class.

All Parish Ministers need to attend one of these sessions (for each specific ministry they're involved with) which will be held in the church.

LECTORS (Proclaimer of the Scripture at Mass): Anyone who can read and talk can be a "Proclaimer of the Scriptures" at Mass! If you're baptized, have made your Confirmation, and have a love of the Scriptures, consider becoming a lector. Workbooks and materials are provided to assist you in your preparations to read at Mass.

Training sessions:

At St. Paul – Tuesday, September 17, at 6:00pm; Saturday, September 21, at 5:30pm; or Sunday, September 22, at 9:00am (*held in the church*).

At St. Patrick – Thursday, September 19, at 6:00pm; or Sunday, September 22, at 12noon (*held in the church*).

EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS (formally known as Extra-ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion): Any Catholic, age 16 and older, who has received the Sacrament of Confirmation, is encouraged to be commissioned for this Ministry. Eucharistic Ministers assist in the distribution of Holy Communion at our Masses, but also can take Communion to the sick in their homes, at the hospital, and to the nursing homes in our area.

Training sessions:

At St. Paul – Tuesday, September 24, at 6:00pm; Saturday, September 28, at 5:30pm; or Sunday, September 29, at 9:00am (*held in the church*).

At St. Patrick – Thursday, September 26, at 6:00pm; or Sunday, September 29, at 12noon (*held in the church*).

ALTAR SERVERS: This ministry is open to **ALL** Catholics. Children (*grade 4 and up, who have made their First Communion*), teenagers, and adults (*men and women, who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation*) are welcome to become Altar Servers. Adults are particularly needed for Funeral Masses, but parents are invited to serve with their child at Weekend Masses, too.

Training sessions:

At St. Paul – Tuesday, October 1, at 6:00pm; Saturday, October 5, at 5:30pm; or Sunday, October 6, at 9:00am (*held in the church*).

At St. Patrick – Wednesday, October 2, at 6:00pm; or Sunday, October 6, at 12noon (*held in the church*).

USHERS AND GREETERS: These "*Ministers of Hospitality*" serve to help welcome people to our parish church. They assist people in finding seats and in helping with the collection and distribution of parish bulletins. All Catholics of any age (*including whole families*) can serve as Greeters or Ushers. "On the job" training is available for the asking at either parish!

MUSIC MINISTERS: Anyone with an inclination toward music (*vocalists for the choir or cantor, plus any type of musical instrumentalists*) is invited to share your musical talent within our parish liturgies. All ages and vocal ranges are welcome and invited.

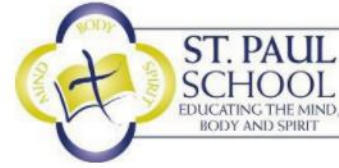

The Ohio Academy of Science selected 40 Ohio schools and 436 teachers to receive The Governor's Thomas Edison Award for Excellence in STEM Education and Student Research for their accomplishments during the 2023-2024 school year.

The criteria for the Thomas Edison Award for Excellence are: (1) Conduct a local science fair with 12 or more students and have two or more of these students participate in the District Science Day or have 6 or more students participate in the District Science Day when no local has been conducted, (2) Students must participate in at least one more youth science opportunity beyond the classroom. The Ohio Academy of Science defines STEM education as both the mastery and integration of science technology, engineering, and mathematics for all PK-12 students. It incorporates scientific inquiry and technological design through student-focused, project-based curricula to develop skills of communication, teamwork/collaboration, creativity/innovation, critical thinking, and problem solving.

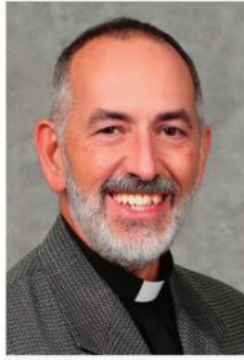
