The Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund has been established by the Diocese of Youngstown as a scholarship granting organization to allow interested donors to reduce their Ohio income tax liability on a dollar-for-dollar basis up to \$750

per person per year (\$1,500 if married filing jointly) by providing donors with a tax credit against their Ohio income tax liability.

As a result of legislation passed in 2021, Ohio taxpayers who wish to support Catholic education in Ohio now have the opportunity to receive a tax credit against Ohio income tax liability for cash contributions made to certified organizations that grant scholarships to K-12 students, including students attending Catholic schools.

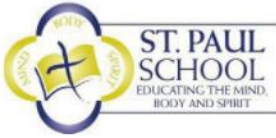

Saint Paul School Improvements

Improvements at the school between August 2023 & August 2024.
Any purchased items/materials were made through grants, gifts, and special funds

WiFi Upgrades

Working with Salem Computing Center using grant funds, the building's WiFi servers, access points, and connectivity have been upgraded to ensure reliable and ubiquitous high-speed coverage throughout our building

Free Breakfast and Lunch

Based on Provision 2 from the USDA School Nutrition Program, all St. Paul School students will receive a free breakfast and lunch this year.

New cafeteria tables

Through state/federal funding including our school lunch program, St. Paul School has updated their lunchroom seating to state-of-the-art folding/rolling cafeteria tables. These tables meet and exceed safety standards and will make it possible for the entire gym to be used when needed! They feature a one-hand lift mechanism and upgraded surfaces so that they can last for years to come.

New special event tables and chairs

Through a grant, we were able to purchase 410 heavy-duty folding chairs and 27 lifetime folding tables for meetings and events in Scullion Hall (our gym). Thank you to the St. Paul School Foundation for funding the purchase of 4 rolling racks that hold these items for tidy storage. We hope you enjoy using this new furniture at our family programs.

Upgrade to LED lighting throughout building

LED light purchases were made to move from our current fluorescent fixtures to more economical, long-lasting LED lights. The new daylight LEDs are brighter but less harsh—we hope this improvement helps save money and improves the reading conditions in the school.

New Chromebooks & Covers

St. Paul School features a 1:1 initiative, where every student has a device (tablet, Chromebook, or laptop). We were very excited this year to be able to update one third of our devices. We are working on Chromebook insurance options for families at a minimal cost. We also purchased protective covers for every device

New lunch trays, bowls, silverware,

Funded through our Federal nutrition programs, new student trays, cutlery, and bowls were purchased for the school. This marks the first time our student serveware has been replaced in a few decades!

New cafeteria commercial steam oven

Another item funded by the Federal nutrition program, an exciting new commercial steam oven was added to the St. Paul School cafeteria kitchen. This oven will provide us with additional healthy cooking options for our in-school meal preparation!

New choir risers and music program resources

Three sets of new portable choir risers were purchased for our music classes and concerts. These can be set up and removed in between numbers during programs and are easily stored.

New VEX Robotics systems in lower-level renovated MakerSpace

This year we will debut our VEX robotics kits. We were able to purchase class sets of VEX123, VEXGo, and VEXIQ. Constructing and coding will be exciting for our students. These are in addition to our 3D Ozobots, Hexbugs, Dot & Dash robots, and more! pens, 3D printers,

New classroom furnishings

Interactive collaboration ("Smartboard") TVs in ALL instructional classrooms

Every classroom has a new Sharp Collaboration board that allows teachers to project materials for the entire class. Using touch-screen technology, students and teachers can interact with course content to learn and practice new skills.

New classroom furnishings

Preschool

New student cubbies and rectangular tables (replacing former large round tables) to increase room capacity and maximize play and learning areas.

Science Lab (grades 4-8)

Older rusty/damaged tables and chairs were replaced with new chemical-resistant lab tables and stools for student science experiments and work.

Social Studies (grades 4-8)

New classroom tables and chairs replaced old rusty, chipped/damaged desks and wooden chairs.

English Language Arts (grades 4-8)

New classroom tables and chairs and book shelves.

Art/STEM (grades P-8)

New round stools for work on former computer lab tables on art projects

Music/Choir/Band (grades P-8)

New plastic student chairs have replaced wooden ones, resulting in less splinters.

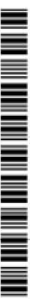

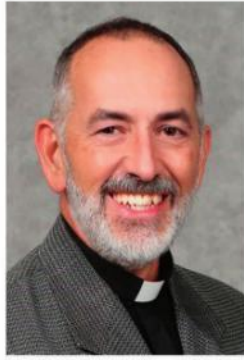
