





All Saints Day

This Holy Day originated in the 4th century's Eastern feast of All Martyrs, and is attested to by St. Ephrem (c. 373 AD). Pope Gregory IV established this commemoration for all the Roman Church in 835. Originally celebrated on Easter Friday, it came to be held in Rome on May 13; later, in the 9th century, it was transferred to November 1, the date of its celebration in Ireland where it was established to counter (and eventually replace) the Celtic pagan feast of the Druids.

On this day, we honor the memory of all the Saints in heaven. May their prayers on our behalf, and their intercession before God, strengthen us to follow their example of holiness that we too may be looked upon as saints in our lives. All Saints Day is celebrated this year with Masses on Thursday, October 31, at 7:00 p.m. at St. Paul, and on Friday, November 1, at 9:00 a.m. at St. Paul and at 7:00 p.m. at St. Patrick.

All Souls Day



The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day) is also rooted in ancient Christian tradition, as attested to by the 2nd century Christian historian Tertullian. St. Odilo of Cluny established a memorial of all the faithful departed in 988 AD. This celebration was officially accepted for the whole Roman Church in the 13th century.

On November 2, as we honor all of our beloved dead, we pray for their eternal rest in heaven and ask them to pray for us that we may be found worthy of the eternal gift of Heaven.


