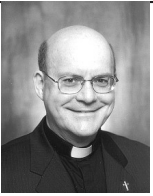

Father Bob's Corner .

Dear Friends,

Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen.

- Hebrews 11:1

We hope for eternal life with God and we have evidence of things beyond our sight. Our faith embraces these facets of our lives and is nourished by them. We live our lives by faith. Sometimes our feelings come alive when we are moved by faith; but faith is not our feelings, nor dependent on them. Faith is a gift from God. We practice our faith when we pray and when we act on the beliefs we hold. God, help us grow in faith.

We pray for victims of violence from recent shootings in California, Texas and Ohio. The Pope, the United States Bishops and numerous government officials have expressed their sorrow, prayers, dismay, and sometimes commitments to work for safer environments. Our greatest recourse is to turn to God and ask for mercy, to pray for greater love for one another, and to act for peace. May God help us as we decide how we can best be witnesses to Christ and the Peace he brings.

A survey of parents of students who attend religious education classes at St. Patrick and St. Paul has been e-mailed. We hope parents will respond.

In the pews today are questionnaires that will help us poll our parishioners about future Mass Times for our parishes. This is in response to diocesan policy asking that priests only have three scheduled Masses for the weekend. That means we will keep our Saturday Mass at St. Paul at 4:30 pm, but one of the Sunday Masses at St. Paul will need to be discontinued. Times of the remaining Sunday Masses may change as we consider our religious education program on Sunday, too. Please do your best to help us make a smooth transition to adjusting our Mass times.

The **Feast of Mary's Assumption into heaven is Thursday, August 15. It is a Holyday of Obligation.** Please check for Mass times at our parishes. Adoration at St. Paul will be held in the Parish Center from 10 am to 7 pm and then resume in church.

Dr. Scott Hahn is scheduled to speak at St. Paul Parish on Saturday, August 17, from 9-12 am. We hope to have a good turnout so make sure your grass is mowed, your groceries are packed away and join us. All are welcome.

Many things are happening in our parishes, especially as we prepare for school to resume this month. **St. Paul School will open for classes on Wednesday, August 21.** Make the most of the vacation time that remains.

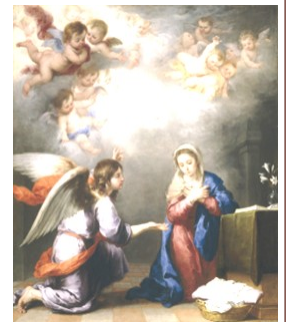

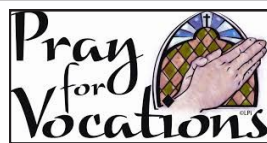
