Rosary on the 1st & 3rd Monday of the month will be cancelled until further notice.

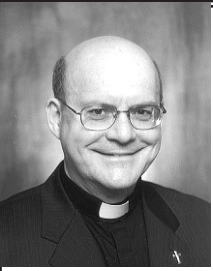
