Father Bob's Corner.



Dear Friends,

Welcome Back! St. Paul School and many other local schools have opened their doors for the new school year. May God bless all our students, faculty and staff as they return. CCD religion classes will start later next month.

Preaching this weekend is Deacon Larry Pasko. He is a parishioner of St. Patrick Parish.

Sister Mary Ann McFadden recently announced that she will retire from St. Paul Salem and Centro San Pablo December 31st, at the end of the year. Sister will be in our prayers as she moves in the direction of retirement. Meanwhile, interviews are taking place for a part-time replacement for someone to direct Centro San Pablo.

Our reading from Sirach (Ecclesiasticus – sometimes confused with Ecclesiastes which is also known as Qoheleth) and the passage from the Gospel according to Luke, encourage us to acquire the virtue of humility. But the second reading, from the Letter to the Hebrews seems to instill the opposite. It contrasts the experience of the Israelites at Mount Sinai, and the giving of the covenant with Moses to the new covenant we have received through the blood of Jesus Christ.

...you have approached Mount Zion ...and countless angels, and the assembly of the firstborn, and God ..., and the spirits of the just ..., and Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and the sprinkled blood that speaks more eloquently than that of Abel. - Hebrews 12:22-24

However, verses 14 & 15 of that passage says, "Strive for peace with everyone, and for that holiness, without which no one will see the Lord. See to it that no one is deprived of the grace of God...." That tends to point us to acquire even more humility than those who received the covenant with Moses. Let's pray that we can understand the virtue of humility and grow in it.

Someone (I can't remember who) asked me about a woman who has frequently attended daily Mass and hasn't been seen in awhile. Well, I recently spoke with the "missing woman." She is well but has family obligations which keep her from attending daily Mass. She has been able to come to Adoration and Sunday Mass, though. That's a friendly cue for us to get to know one another better. Try to make it a point to meet someone new at Mass this month.

Enjoy the remaining days of August; September is just down the block.

Dear Jesus, make us merciful like the Father and help us enter through the narrow door. May we never take our faith for granted.


