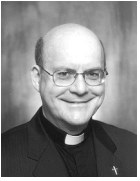

Happy Word of God Sunday! *Happy Catholic Schools Week!*

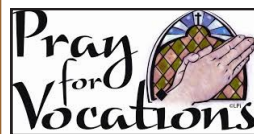
WARM HOMES
