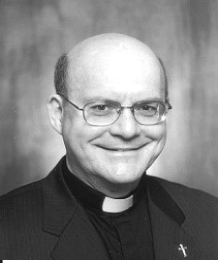

Dear Friends,

“But some seed fell on rich soil, and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold. Whoever has ears ought to hear.” (Matthew 13:8-9) Hearing the word of the Lord, reading the word of the Lord, familiarizing ourselves with the word of the Lord – all these activities produce fruit within us.
