Mass has resumed. Confessions are by appointment, and I try to be available on Saturdays at 3:30 pm at St. Paul Church, but using one of the rooms in the old offices for more open space. The only option for Reconciliation, currently, is face to face. I am available to come to your home, if you would like, to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, too.

Many of our Parishioners are watching us on Facebook, local TV, or WFMJ. Some do not have access to any of these options and are watching other Masses on television. That is always good to hear. Keep the faith, share it with others. That is the way of living the New Evangelization during the pandemic. Keep praying for those in health care, first responders, and all those who work in public service trying to help us keep safe. Pray for those in nursing homes and prisons. Pray for our Nation and all the world. Pray for those who are separated from those they love. God bless us everyone. Pray for those on vacation! I just found, being cautious, that I could find virtual vacations online and on YouTube, and free museums online! That might be my vacation spot today!
