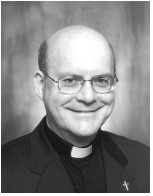

St. Paul School Foundation Awards 2019 Annual Scholarships

Congratulations to Jackson Corbisello & Joselyn Miller, first-place winners of the 2019 St. Paul School Foundation Scholarship! Runners-up are MacKenzie Jeric, Megan Malysa, Zachary Tungate, Luke Weingart, and John Paul Yuhanick. These 2013 St. Paul School graduates shared a total of \$8,400 in financial assistance for their first year of college education. Jackson and Zachary plan to attend Ohio State; Joselyn and Luke will enroll in the University of Mount Union. John Paul plans to study at Youngstown State. MacKenzie will study and play volleyball at LaRoche University, and Megan will attend Kent State.

High school seniors who graduated from St. Paul School are eligible for the scholarship. Awards are based on grade point average, parish youth ministry involvement, two letters of recommendation, and an essay that describes educational and career plans and the impact of a St. Paul School Catholic education on an applicant's academic achievement. The foundation is proud to help these alumni and encourages them return often to St. Paul. Pentecost

Diocesan Youth Day at Cedar Point

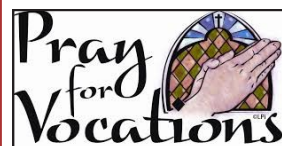


Tuesday, June 18, 2019 (10am-10pm)
