Legion of Mary

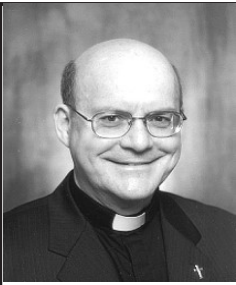
Legion of Mary meets on Mondays at 12:30 in the Rectory Meeting Room.

Dear Friends,

*“I am the living bread that came down from heaven,
whoever eats this bread will live forever;
and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.”*

John 6:51

Jesus' words in today's Gospel remind us of our reason for celebrating Mass – to feast on the living bread come down from heaven. We commune with our divine Lord while here on our pilgrimage to eternal life. Still, the quarrelling that occurred among the crowd of Jesus' day has often occurred among the historical crowds since that time. But we profess with Peter, in verse 68 (not part of today's reading), “Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.” The gift of the Eucharist is something of which we are unworthy. Yet, the Lord has spoken the word which heals our soul and allows us to approach and receive.

Sunday Masses have resumed at our regularly scheduled times. You may enter through the side doors near the ramp and the statue of Mary at St. Paul, and through the front doors at St. Patrick. You are requested to wear a mask, use hand sanitizer, and maintain social distancing. Please approach the priest at the end of the line if you choose to receive Holy Communion on the tongue.

Mr. Stephen Carattini, Director for Social Concerns of the Diocese of Youngstown, has reminded us that our late Bishop Murry was a member of the USCCB Ad Hoc Committee on Racism in 2017. The USCCB Committee on Cultural Diversity in the Church approved and published its document ***Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love – A Pastoral Letter Against Racism***, in November 2018.
