# Father Bob's Corner.

Dear Friends,

...much more did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflow for the many. Romans 5:15

God has not only gifted us with life (which we often disregard, disrespect or neglect), but with grace to be healed of sin and the effects of sin in the world. On this Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we have a passage from the fifth chapter of St. Paul's letter to the Romans. Previous selections would have been presented to us if we had not celebrated Pentecost and the Feasts of the Holy Trinity and the Body and Blood of Christ. (The 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Sundays would have had readings from Romans 3:21-25a, 28; 4:18-25 and 5:6-11.)

The letter to the Romans is St. Paul's longest letter. Because his letters are placed in order of length, it is the first letter of his works in the New Testament. It follows right after Act of the Apostles. We will have selections from this great work until September 17, the 24<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time! That's impressive enough to consider reading St. Paul's Letter to the Romans. Sixteen chapters in four months doesn't sound all that bad.

During this year's **Fortnight for Freedom** (June 21-July 4), our United States Bishops again ask us to *pray, reflect* and act. Pray for the gift of freedom for which Christ offered himself on the Cross to be firmly imbedded in our souls. Reflect on the lives and deaths of the heroes of our faith and of the founders of our country. Act in freedom to bring about renewal in our lives. Check out the USCCB website for more information – www.usccb.org.

If you are going away or on vacation, check for Mass Schedules where you will travel at masstimes.org or catholicmasstime.org. It's always a good idea to call before you go to make sure you have the latest correct information. If you are having a stay at home vacation, plan to make an extra Mass during the week, come to adoration on Thursday, take a short pilgrimage to a nearby shrine. Enjoy!


