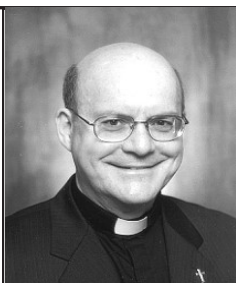

The quote above from St. Paul's letter to the Romans reminds them and us of our Baptism into the dying and rising of Christ.
