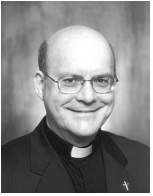

## Father Bob's Corner .

Dear Friends,

**Whoever is in Christ is a new creation.... – 2 Corinthians 5:17**

“Are we there yet?” is a question that children often ask their parents when traveling to a distant location. Today is Laetare Sunday, and the Church tells us to “be happy” because we are halfway on our journey to Easter and 50 days of celebrating that joyful season. We can be happy that God is like the Prodigal Father – ready to receive his repentant sons and daughters.

Our Lenten Communal Penance Service is on Sunday, April 7, at 3:00 pm, at St. Paul Church. All are welcome. Mercy will be available for “older brothers” and “younger brother” types – and those who have difficulty identifying with either. God is good – all the time.

Monday’s comic section of the newspaper caused me to chuckle. In Family Circus a grandchild says to grandma, “How ‘bout we make this one of our good ol’ days.” It reminds me of Carol King’s recording of Anticipation: “These are the good old days.” Try to be good natured on April First! Remember that Jesus played the greatest joke on the devil.

Men who attended the Catholic Men’s Fellowship Conference at St. Thomas Aquinas High School on Saturday, March 23, commented on how much they appreciated Bishop Murry’s clarification of the clergy

scandals. His point was that the press is reporting cases that happened in the past; in the past five years few, if any, cases have occurred. I’m disappointed that I was unable to attend the conference this year.

St. Oscar Romero, pray for us. The feast of the martyred Archbishop of El Salvador occurred for the first time on March 24, but the Second Sunday in Lent took precedence. The Feast of the Annunciation was Monday, so St. Oscar will have the day to himself next year. I caught part of the movie Romero which aired on EWTN Sunday night and was reminded how so many of today’s problems have their roots in things that happened long ago. Yet the saints are urging us forward by their prayers for us.

Please make your pledge to the Annual Bishop’s Appeal. Envelopes are still in your pews.

Please pray for all our parishioners who are ill. Do your best to stay healthy since there are “things” going around and many people say they are feeling “worn out.” Let us choose to be in solidarity with each other in prayer. It’s so good to hear people report that they are getting better.
