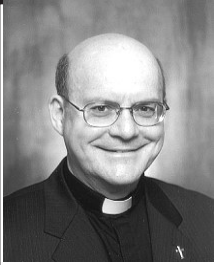

Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer, and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God....

- Philippians 4:6-7

St. Paul gives us directions for obtaining peace and avoiding anxiety. It's something we can sure use these days. He goes on to tell us to think of uplifting things. This isn't to deny reality but to recognize that reality isn't all negative. It reminds me of the quote in Romans 12:21, "Do not be conquered by evil but conquer evil with good." This takes place right within us.
