PRAYING FOR OUR POLICE FORCE

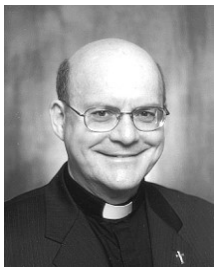
All are invited to join other members of our parish to pray for the safety of our police force. We will meet on Saturday, October 31, at noon at the police station at 231 South Broadway to show our support.
