
2025 St. Paul School Foundation Scholarship Award

Congratulations to the winners of the annual St. Paul School Foundation senior scholarship! The Foundation awarded \$2,000 each in financial assistance to five St. Paul School graduates for their first year of college education. The recipients and the schools they plan to attend are Andrew Beck, The Ohio State University; Maggie Hall, undecided; Journey Jenkins, Kent State, Salem Campus; Jillian Pieren, Youngstown State University; Nathan Yakubek, The Pennsylvania State University.

High school seniors who graduated from St. Paul School, Salem Ohio, are eligible for the scholarship. Awards are based on grade point average, parish involvement, two letters of recommendation and an essay that describes educational and career plans and the impact of a St. Paul School Catholic education on an applicant's academic achievement. Since establishing the scholarship in 1995, the foundation has awarded \$168,450 to 154 (including this year's scholarship winners) St. Paul School Graduates. 




