

Leave Your Comfort Zone to Reach More

Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which was in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

- Philippians 2:4-7



In the Incarnation, God the Son left the comforts of Heaven and plunged into the mess of our world, to reach us right where we were. Ever since Pentecost, God has been reaching more through those who let themselves be reached by him.

Who is God going to reach in and through you?

This month, pray about where the Lord is calling you to reach more. "More" might mean more people or it might mean more depth of relationship with someone you already know.

What is one concrete way you can leave your own comfort zone with the aim of reaching more?

Here are a few ideas, but don't limit the Holy Spirit! Remember, "the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you" (Romans 8:11)!

Prayerfully consider if God is calling you to step out of your comfort zone to "reach more" in any of these ways.



- Invite someone who is seemingly far from God or the Church to hang out or grab a meal with you.
- Show extra kindness and proactively do something good for someone who makes you feel uncomfortable.
- Spend quality social time with someone you disagree with.
- Take the first step to repair a strained relationship.
- Say yes to an invitation you are tempted to turn down out of discomfort to put someone else's interests over your own.
- Invite a homeless person out for a meal and conversation.
- Talk to someone about a question or topic you feel called to bring up but have shied away from out of fear or discomfort.
- Say hello to someone you always see at Mass but have never talked to and learn their name.
- Ask some coworkers to grab drinks or food after work.
- Gently ask a friend or family member why they stopped going to Mass and listen compassionately to the answer without trying to fix or defend.
