"Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you." -

Luke 14:13-14

One of the main principles of living a stewardship lifestyle is to give without expecting anything in return.

This is difficult for some to comprehend in our "consumerist" culture that we live in.

This is even difficult for many parish communities that have become heavily dependent on parish fundraising events to support the mission and ministry of their local parish.

Generally speaking, at a parish fundraiser, you pay money and receive something in return, it's just a financial transaction.

This is opposed to our parish offertory at Holy Mass, where you unite your sacrifice with Jesus', renewing our covenant relationship with Him.

Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross September 14

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, also known as the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross, commemorates three historical events: the discovery of the True Cross in 326, its initial exaltation for public veneration in 335, and the recovery of the Cross from the Persians in 628. Nowadays, this feast also celebrates the boundless impact of Christ's Cross upon all of creation.

Celebrated each year on September 14, this year this Feast Day lands on a Sunday and will be celebrated at all our Masses that weekend. In "Exaltation" of the Cross, you are asked to bring your family's home crucifix to Mass that weekend to receive a special blessing.

May the Cross of Christ – in our Church, in our home or on our jewelry – always be a reminder of the salvation God has given to us by means of the wood of the cross.
