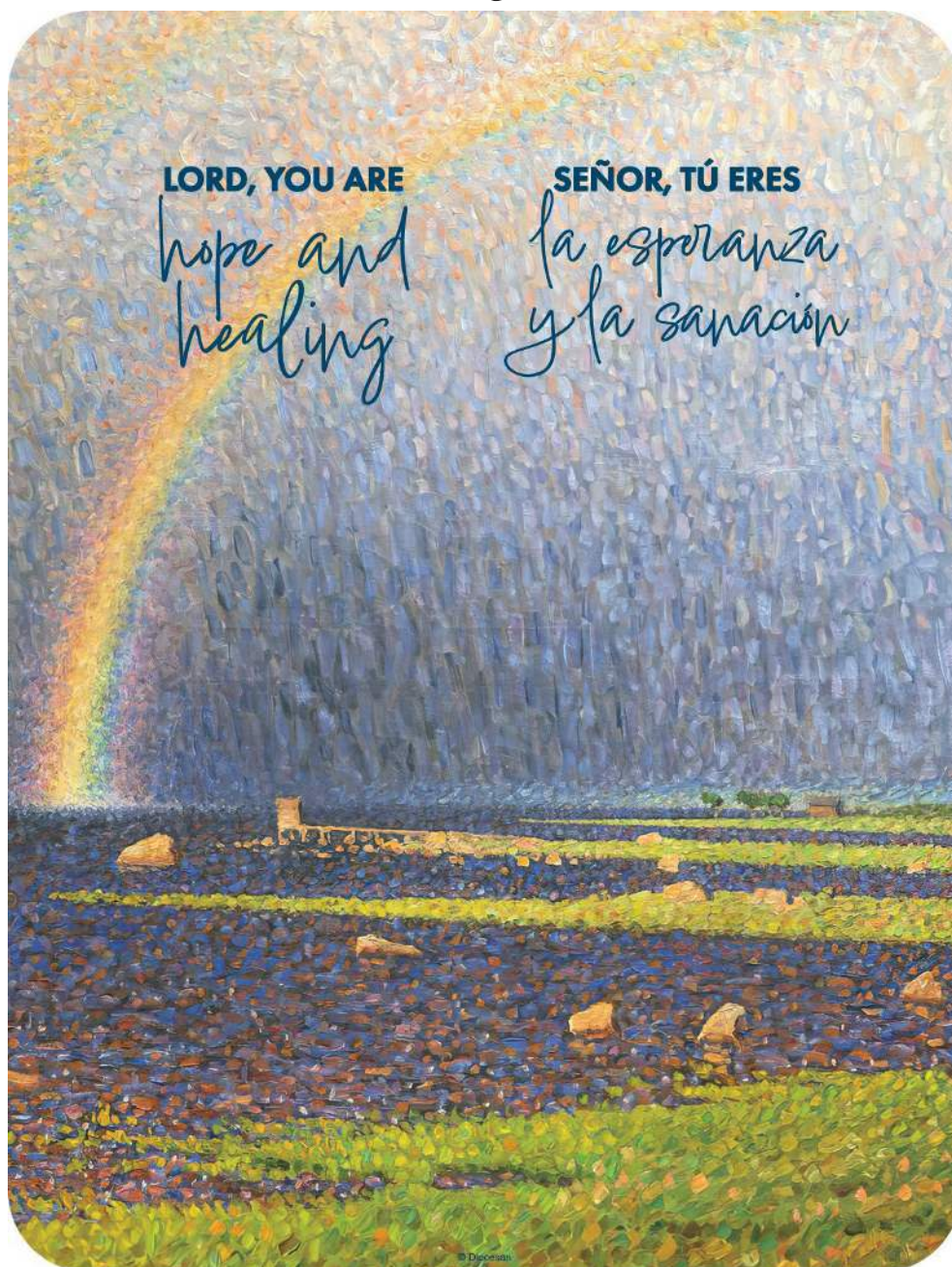

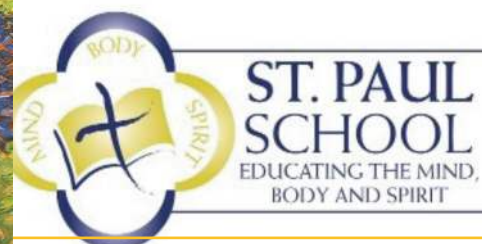
St. George & St. Paul Parishes

HAVE YOU BEEN CONFIRMED?

A preparation program for adults who are Baptized Catholics but not yet confirmed will be held at our Parish this fall. This is a special opportunity for anyone (age 18 or older) who has not received the sacrament. Candidate eligibility will be verified through baptism records and marital status. Sponsors must be baptized, confirmed, practicing Catholic and may not be the candidate's parent. RESPONSIBILITY**

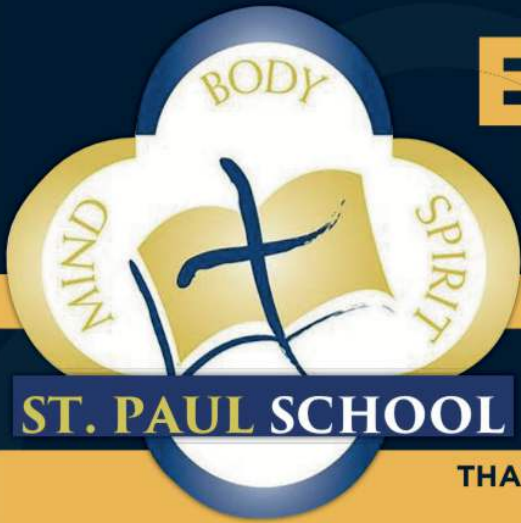
Empower parishioners to work with the pastor in stewarding the parish's mission and resources. Invite everyone to participate in parish ministry and to care for staff and facilities.

New EdChoice Expansion applicants will need to complete the income verification process, unless the family has previous household income on file. Income verification is optional for renewal applications in the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship program. Scholarships for EdChoice Expansion are awarded based on the Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of a family's household. If a family's household income is at or below 450 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, they will be awarded the maximum scholarship amount. If a family's household income is at or above 451 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, the student's scholarship award will be prorated based on their specific percentage of the Federal Poverty Level.

The scholarship can only be used to pay tuition. Parents and/or guardians may have to pay registration fees, material fees and other similar types of fees. Families who qualify for low-income status (at or below 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines) do not have to pay any tuition beyond the amount of the scholarship. Families applying for low-income status must submit new household income annually. If the private school's tuition is higher than the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship amount and the family does not qualify for low-income status, the family may have to pay the difference.
