



on Tuesdays February 24 - March 24 from 6:30-8:00PM.**



The Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund has been established by the Diocese of Youngstown as a scholarship granting organization to allow interested donors to reduce their Ohio income tax liability on a dollar-for-dollar basis up to \$750 per person per year (\$1,500 if married filing jointly) by providing donors with a tax credit against their Ohio income tax liability.

As a result of legislation passed in 2021, Ohio taxpayers who wish to support Catholic education in Ohio now have the opportunity to receive a tax credit against Ohio income tax liability for cash contributions made to certified organizations that grant scholarships to K-12 students, including students attending Catholic schools.

Donations to the Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund will be utilized to award scholarships to students attending Catholic schools in the Diocese of Youngstown with a priority to support low-income families that seek high quality educational opportunities for their children. Donations may be submitted to the Office of Catholic Schools accompanied by the donation form. Donations may be designated to support Catholic education throughout the Diocese of Youngstown or to support Catholic education at a specific school. The Diocese of Youngstown Catholic Schools are dedicated to providing students and families with an excellent educational experience that nurtures faith, inspires learning, fosters service, and builds leadership.

How to Make a Donation

1. Estimate your Ohio tax liability.

The scholarship is capped at the lesser of your Ohio state tax liability OR \$750 per taxpayer (\$1,500 for married filing jointly).

2. Make your donation.

Visit www.doy.org/sgo to give online OR download a contribution form and mail to the Office of Catholic Schools.

3. Claim your scholarship tax credit when you file your State of Ohio income tax return.

You may be asked to submit your donation receipt. The credit is entered on the Ohio Tax Return Schedule of Credits, line 15. Donations made by April 15th can be counted for the previous year's taxes.

This does not constitute income tax advice.

Always consult a tax professional for information on the impact of any charitable donation.

4. Accept the thanks and appreciation of families and students who will benefit.

How can a donation be made to the Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund?

Currently donations are being accepted by check or credit card, made payable to the "Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund". All payment should be accompanied by a Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund Donor Form.

May a donor designate a Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund contribution to a specific school?

Yes. Donors to the Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund have the option of making:

a.) An undesignated contribution that supports schools and students in the area of greatest need across the Diocese of Youngstown,

OR b.) A contribution that is designated to benefit students at a specific Catholic school in the Diocese of Youngstown. In either case, scholarships to low-income families will be prioritized.

May a donor designate a Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund contribution to a specific student?

No. As a 501(c)(3) organization, the Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund does not accept contributions designated for specific students.




