



St. George & St. Paul Parishes



THE BLESSING OF EASTER BASKETS AND FOODS BASKET CONTENTS AND SYMBOLISM

A typical Eastern European Easter basket of food to bless on Holy Saturday would include a variety of symbolic foods. Families may personalize their basket.

- Eggs:** Decorated Ukrainian pysanky or various dyed or plain white eggs symbolize hope, new life and Christ’s Resurrection from the tomb.
- Butter:** Dairy products symbolize the celebration of the end of Lent and the richness of our salvation. It also reminds us of the goodness of Christ that we should have toward all things.
- Easter Bread:** A round, sweetened, yeast loaf. Paska or rye, topped with a cross, symbolic of Jesus, the Bread of Life.
- Horseradish:** Symbolic of the bitterness and harshness of the Passion of Christ. Mixed with vinegar symbolizes the sour wine given to Jesus on the cross. It may be white or red (mixed with shredded beets)
- Pepper:** Symbolizes the Passion of Christ and bitter herbs.
- Kielbasa:** Symbolic of the Christ’s death and rising from the dead as well as God’s favor and generosity.
- Smoked bacon:** Its great fattiness symbolizes the overabundance of God’s mercy and generosity.
- Salt:** Symbolic of a necessary element in our physical life. Also of purification, prosperity, and justice; Preserves us from corruption.
- Cheese:** Symbolic of the moderation Christians should practice. Usually fresh, cry curd or farmer’s cheese shaped into a ball.
- Sweets:** Symbolizes the promise of eternal life or of good things to come. Usually fruits, candy, poppyseed and nut rolls, and pastry.
- Ham, Lamb, or Veal:** Meats are symbolic of great joy and abundance in Christ’s Resurrection.

THE SEASON OF LENT - 2026

Throughout Lent we prepare ourselves for the glorious celebration of our Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. In our Lenten journey toward Easter, may we seek a change of heart and a deeper conversion to the Gospel.

A REMINDER OF THE "RULES" OF LENT

Abstinence is avoiding all meat and all foods prepared with meat (sauces, gravies, soups made from meat stock, etc.). All Catholics age 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and on Good Friday.

Fasting is minimally defined as eating only one full meal and two lighter meals (which together do not equal the one full meal) a day, and nothing between meals. The Church requires all Catholics 18-years to 60-years-old to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. (Additionally, the Good Friday fast day may be extended until the Easter Vigil as "a fast of anticipation" observed by the parish in union with the Catechumens preparing for Baptism.) Fasting on additional days of Lent is encouraged, but not required.

*The Church considers these traditions of fast and abstinence as positive disciplines. Our motivation is **not** to deny the goodness of creation or to "punish" the body. Through this discipline of self-sacrifice, we strive to be united in the sacrificial love of Christ, to be freed from self-centeredness, and to develop a deeper prayer life and a greater sense of charity.*

Prayer and Almsgiving are also traditional Lenten practices. While there are no "rules" for these, the Church encourages all people to spend additional time in private and public prayer as part of their preparation for Easter. Acts of charity (almsgiving) also help us express the self-sacrifice of Lent by our generosity to the less fortunate.
