





The Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund has been established by the Diocese of Youngstown as a scholarship granting organization to allow interested donors to reduce their Ohio income tax liability on a dollar-for-dollar basis up to \$750 per person per year (\$1,500 if married filing jointly) by providing donors with a tax credit against their Ohio income tax liability. As a result of legislation passed in 2021, Ohio taxpayers who wish to support Catholic education in Ohio now have the opportunity to receive a tax credit against Ohio income tax liability for cash contributions made to certified organizations that grant scholarships to K-12 students, including students attending Catholic schools. Donations to the Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund will be utilized to award scholarships to students attending Catholic schools in the Diocese of Youngstown with a priority to support low-income families that seek high quality educational opportunities for their children. Donations may be submitted to the Office of Catholic Schools accompanied by the donation form. Donations may be designated to support Catholic education throughout the Diocese of Youngstown or to support Catholic education at a specific school. The Diocese of Youngstown Catholic Schools are dedicated to providing students and families with an excellent educational experience that nurtures faith, inspires learning, fosters service, and builds leadership.

How to Make a Donation

1. **Estimate your Ohio tax liability.**
The scholarship is capped at the lesser of your Ohio state tax liability OR \$750 per taxpayer (\$1,500 for married filing jointly).
2. **Make your donation.**
Visit www.doy.org/sgo to give online OR download a contribution form and mail to the Office of Catholic Schools.
3. **Claim your scholarship tax credit when you file your State of Ohio income tax return.**
You may be asked to submit your donation receipt. The credit is entered on the Ohio Tax Return Schedule of credits, line 15. Donations made by April 15th can be counted for the previous year's taxes. This does not constitute income tax advice. Always consult a tax professional for information on the impact of any charitable donation.
4. **Accept the thanks and appreciation of families and students who will benefit.**

It's difficult to wrap our brains around suffering. When bad things happen, we want to know why. Why does a good and faithful servant of the Lord have to suffer a protracted and painful death? Why is an innocent child born with a heart defect or must battle cancer? Why does one neighbor lose his home to a natural disaster while another escapes the storm's wrath? We want to give pain meaning, to understand its purpose.

That's what the disciples are wondering when they ask Jesus why the man in today's Gospel is blind. Is his lack of sight a physical manifestation of his sinfulness? Or his parents'? Is God punishing him for some transgression? No, Jesus says. Our Father is loving. Just as our parents would not wish us ill, neither does our Heavenly Father. Pain and suffering exist, but not because God actively wills it. Sorrows in this life are an opportunity to experience God's grace, to draw closer to Him, to identify with the suffering Christ endured on the cross for us. The man's blindness—and cure—helped advance Jesus' ministry in

making God known on earth: "it is so that the works of God might be made visible through him."
