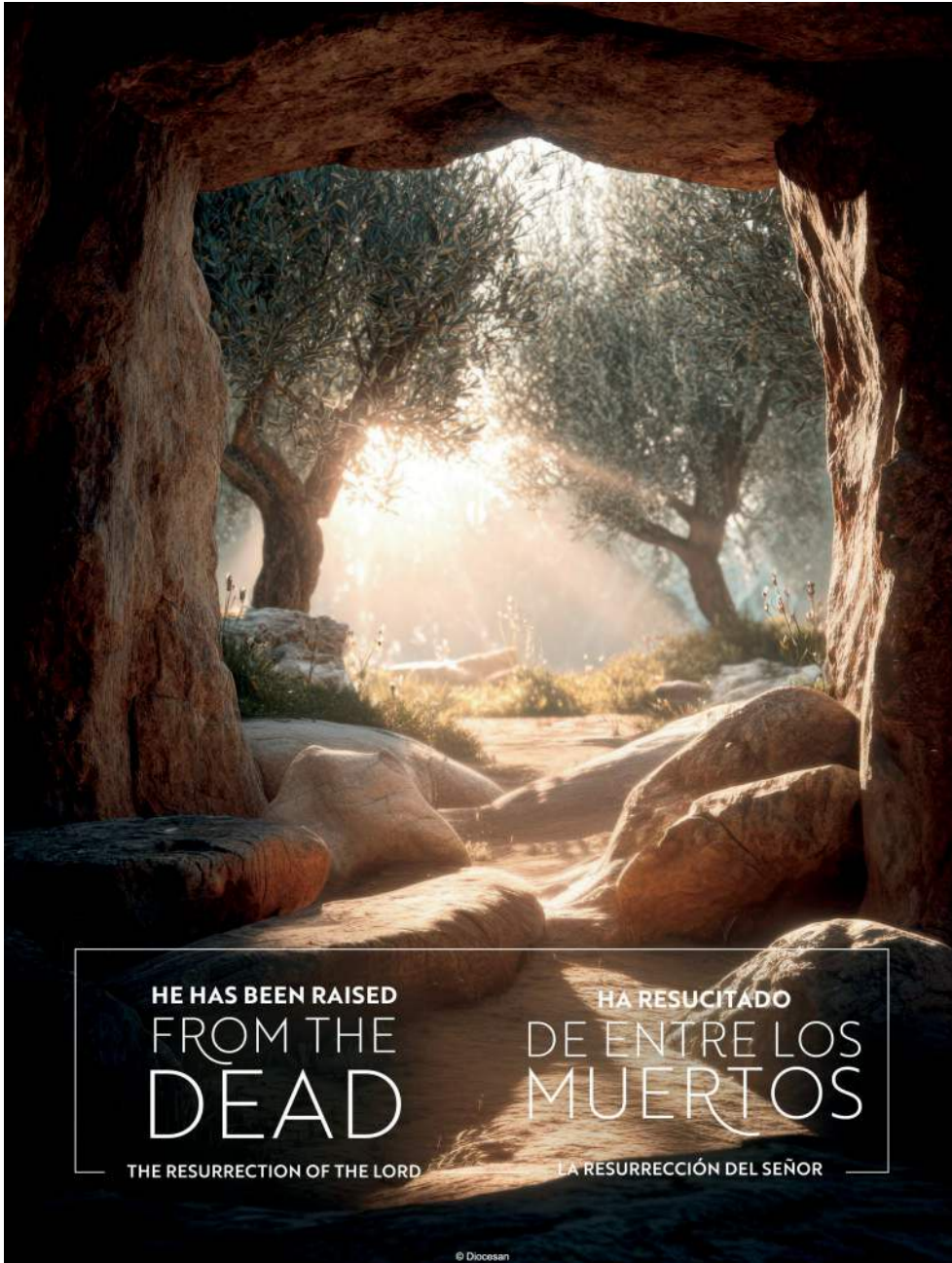
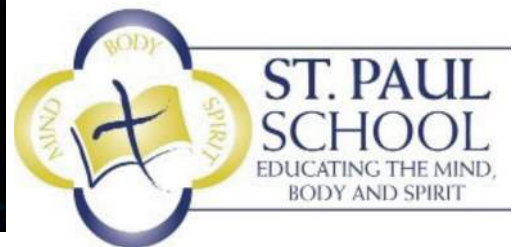


# St. George & St. Paul Parishes

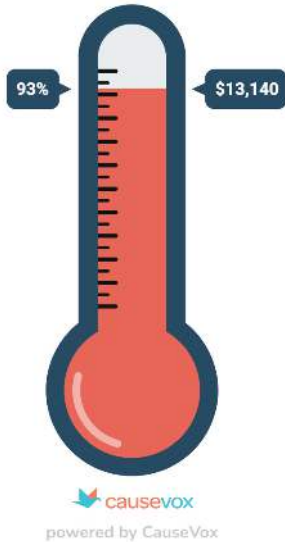

The Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund has been established by the Diocese of Youngstown as a scholarship granting organization to allow interested donors to reduce their Ohio income tax liability on a dollar-for-dollar basis up to \$750 per person per year (\$1,500 if married filing jointly) by providing donors with a tax credit against their Ohio income tax liability. As a result of legislation passed in 2021, Ohio taxpayers who wish to support Catholic education in Ohio now have the opportunity to receive a tax credit against Ohio income tax liability for cash contributions made to certified organizations that grant scholarships to K-12 students, including students attending Catholic schools. Donations to the Good Samaritan Scholarship Fund will be utilized to award scholarships to students attending Catholic schools in the Diocese of Youngstown with a priority to support low-income families that seek high quality educational opportunities for their children. Donations may be submitted to the Office of Catholic Schools accompanied by the donation form. Donations may be designated to support Catholic education throughout the Diocese of Youngstown or to support Catholic education at a specific school. The Diocese of Youngstown Catholic Schools are dedicated to providing students and families with an excellent educational experience that nurtures faith, inspires learning, fosters service, and builds leadership.

#### How to Make a Donation

1. **Estimate your Ohio tax liability.**  
The scholarship is capped at the lesser of your Ohio state tax liability OR \$750 per taxpayer (\$1,500 for married filing jointly).
2. **Make your donation.**  
Visit [www.doy.org/sgo](http://www.doy.org/sgo) to give online OR download a contribution form and mail to the Office of Catholic Schools.
3. **Claim your scholarship tax credit when you file your State of Ohio income tax return.**  
You may be asked to submit your donation receipt. The credit is entered on the Ohio Tax Return Schedule of credits, line 15. Donations made by April 15th can be counted for the previous year's taxes. This does not constitute income tax advice. Always consult a tax professional for information on the impact of any charitable donation.
4. **Accept the thanks and appreciation of families and students who will benefit.**

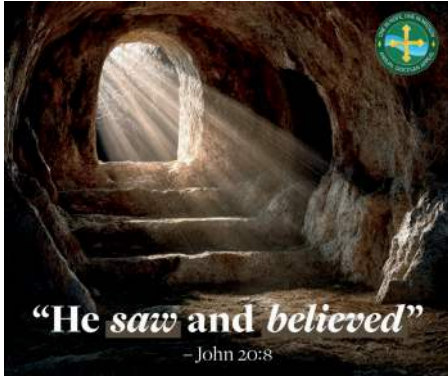

We all experience fear in our lives. We face health scares and job uncertainty. We are frightened by failed relationships. We worry that the life we are living doesn't meet our expectations. When we live in fear, we limit ourselves. Fear constricts. But faith dispels fear and opens our hearts and minds.

Jesus repeatedly tells us throughout his ministry to "be not afraid." He invites us to replace fear with trust – trust in him and in God. This is difficult to do, especially when fear has become a habit. The disciples were fearful after witnessing Jesus' crucifixion. Their friend and teacher was put to death for preaching. They were his followers, so it isn't out of the realm of possibility that they are in danger as well. But first an angel appears to the two Marys, saying, "Do not be afraid" and shares that Christ has risen from the dead. Then

Jesus, himself, appears to the disciples, and the first words out of his mouth are "Do not be afraid." He says that he will be with them always, and he keeps his word. Even death cannot separate them.

Our Lord is with us, too. We can grow in trust that he is always present in our lives by slowing down, retreating into silence, and talking to God through prayer. We can hand over our fears to the Lord because he can handle them! In relinquishing fear's hold, we become open to God working in our lives. And we can share this with others who may be living in fear by supporting such initiatives as the Annual Diocesan Appeal.

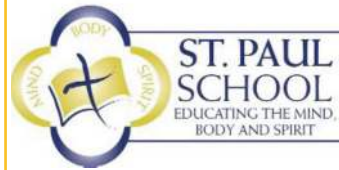
### Save the Date!
