We can relate to what the disciples are feeling at the beginning of today’s Gospel. They are feeling lost and defeated. They gave up everything to follow Jesus, and what did this get them? A long and dusty walk back to their old lives. Feelings of dejection and hopelessness are part of the human condition. But so are feelings of joy and promise. When the disciples first meet Jesus on the road, they do not recognize him. Then their eyes are opened when Jesus joins them for dinner, breaking and blessing the bread as he did during the Last Supper. Despair gives way to hope, their faith is renewed, and, with it, the strength to return to Jerusalem.

Just as Jesus walked alongside the disciples, he accompanies us as well – through Scripture reading and prayer that calms our fears, through friends who bring us meals when our parents die, through our spouses who hug us at the end of a difficult day, even through the quiet of a sunrise that fills us with optimism. When we recognize him, our lives are transformed. And like those disciples, we are called to return with joy and witness to his presence among us. As a Church, we are invited to be companions for others on their journeys – to walk with them, to listen, to break bread, and to reveal Christ through our love and action. 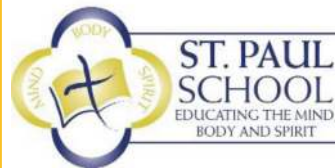
