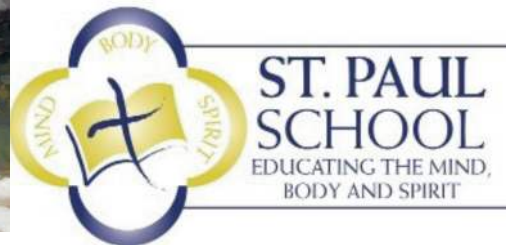


St. George & St. Paul Parishes

The communal celebration of the *Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick* offers us as a community of faith the opportunity to come and share in the healing work of Christ and the Church through anointing with oil. As the Letter of James says, “Are there people among you who are sick? They should summon the priests of the Church, and the priests should pray over the sick and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick persons and the Lord will raise them up. If they have committed any sins, they will be forgiven.” If you know someone who would like to receive this Sacrament, but cannot attend this special Mass, please call the parish office to arrange for a priest to visit them. [NOTE: please do not wait until your loved one is actively dying before calling for this Sacrament. We cannot guarantee the immediate availability of a priest, so try to plan in advance, if possible.]

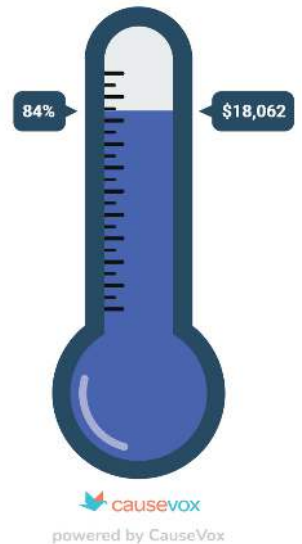
