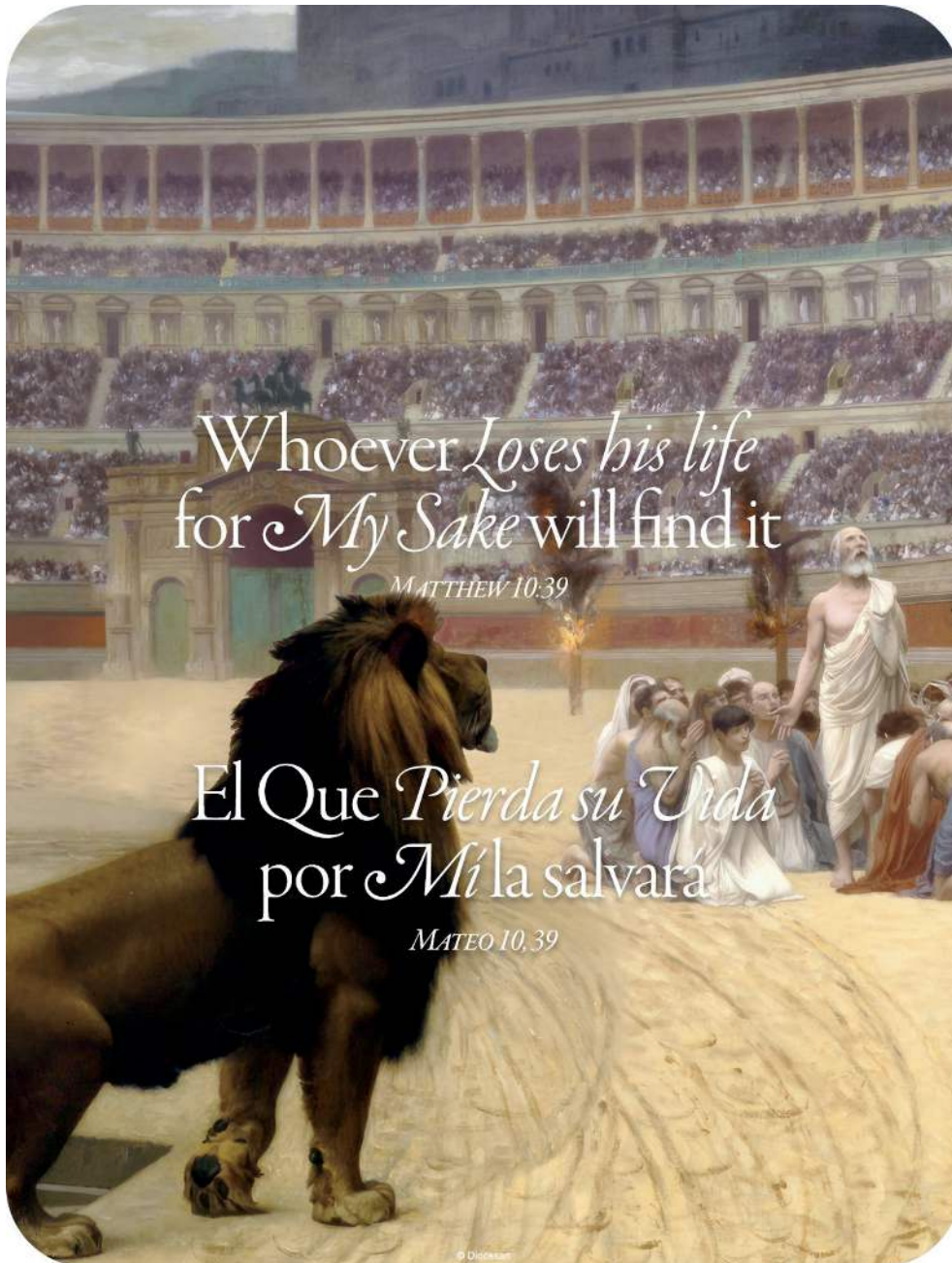
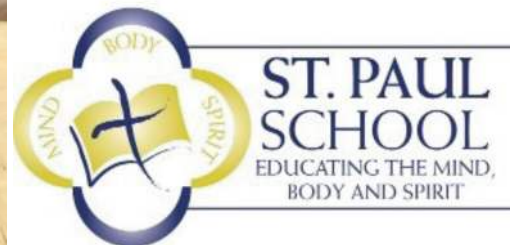


St. George & St. Paul Parishes

2026 St. Paul School Foundation Scholarship Award

Congratulations to the winners of the annual St. Paul School Foundation senior scholarship! The Foundation awarded \$2,500 each in financial assistance to two St. Paul School graduates for their first year of college education. The recipients and the schools they plan to attend are Lucas Dyle, Youngstown State University and Daniel Marin Gonzalez, The Ohio State University.

High school seniors who graduated from St. Paul School, Salem Ohio, are eligible for the scholarship. Awards are based on grade point average, parish involvement, two letters of recommendation and an essay that describes educational and career plans and the impact of a St. Paul School Catholic education on an applicant's academic achievement. Since establishing the scholarship in 1995, the foundation has awarded \$173,450 to 156 (including this year's scholarship winners) St. Paul School Graduates.
