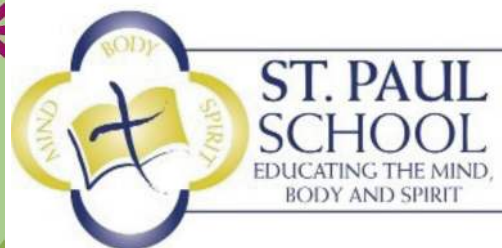

2 Increase the percentage of parishioner's confidence in sharing their faith through evangelism by participating in a church sponsored evangelistic group education session.
